Staples Baseball Hosts the World's Biggest Mets Fan

Prince's other works dive deep into Mets history, including “Faith and Fear in Flushing,” “Amazin' Again” and “The Happiest Recap” series, which is 50 years of Mets history told through a vivid selection of 500 Mets victories. Prince's work and zeal have earned him much acclaim in the Mets community, not to mention many a shout out from Gary Cohen on the SNY broadcasts.

Through it all, Prince prides himself on the passionate community his work has helped build, which will be on full display just weeks before opening day here in Connecticut. Be a part of Mets history with a man at the front of one of the strongest fan bases in the sport by joining Staples Baseball in welcoming Prince to Staples High School on Tuesday, March 21 at 7:00 p.m.
